Ordinance Reducing the Number of Trustees from Six to Four

An Ordinance reducing the number of Village Trustees from six members to four members.

THE VILLAGE OF TEKONSHA ORDAINS:

Section 1 - Purpose.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to make it more certain that the Village Council can be filled with the requisite number of Trustees to ensure quorums to conduct business efficiently.

Section 2 - Enactment.

The Village of Tekonsha ordains that pursuant to MCL 62.1(2), the number of Trustees on the Village Council be and hereinafter is reduced from six (6) to four (4).

Section 3 - Severability.

Should any portion, sentence, paragraph, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional, illegal or of no force or effect by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision or judgment shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof which shall continue to remain in full force and effect.

Section 4 - Repeal of Conflicting Ordinances.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5 - Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective 45 days after its adoption, unless a petition signed by not less than 10% of the registered electors of the Village is filed with the Village Clerk within the 45-day time period, in which case this Ordinance shall take effect upon approval in an election held on the question.

Section 6 - Publication.

This Ordinance shall be published once, in summary form or in full, in *The Tekonsha News*, a newspaper of general circulation within the boundaries of said Village and qualified under State law to publish legal notices, within 15 days of its adoption. The same shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of said Village and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the President and Village Clerk.
